The Mental Health Wellness and Outreach Worker reports directly to the Director of Operations.

POSITION SUMMARY:

The Mental Health Wellness and Outreach Worker is responsible for program development, community engagement and service delivery with priority to the children and youth residing at Munsee-Delaware Nation. A key component of this position is relationship building/engaging skills with children and youth in an effort to make positive changes in their lives. The Mental Health Wellness and Outreach Worker is responsible for providing support to clients to link them to appropriate mental health, life skills and healing programs and services as required.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Plan and implement the delivery of afterschool and Professional Activity Day programs and activities for elementary school aged children.
- Plan and implement the delivery of youth specific programs and activities for secondary school aged youth.
- Plan and implement the delivery of youth specific programs and activities for post-secondary aged youth.
- Respond to crises, in a non-clinical capacity and refer clients to other resources as appropriate.
- Collaborate with the Munsee-Delaware Nation Team on working with children and youth to help them identify steps to achieve their goals.

- Deliver presentations and workshops as required with at least one engagement for the community on a monthly basis.
- Perform other duties as required by the Director of Operations within the scope of the responsibilities of this position.
