The Board requires a qualified Computer Analyst (Web Developer) to work in a full-time capacity.

Responsibilities:

The successful candidate will work within a team to develop and maintain the School Board's websites. Maintaining the SQL Server/Oracle environment using trouble shooting, tuning and security along with creating and maintaining processes and procedures regarding SQL/Oracle administration guidelines, best practices and documentation are additional responsibilities. The successful candidate will provide assistance for connectivity, creation, installation, and migration of database structures and will work with Concrete 5 CMS and HTML along with other duties as assigned. Time outside the normal business day may be required to meet operational needs and respond to emergencies.

Qualifications:

- Minimum relevant (3) year college diploma in computer technology/programming required (i.e. Computer Technology Analyst or Computer Programmer/Analyst)
- Minimum of 2 years relevant IT work experience required in any of the following:
 - development of applications in Visual Studio using the .NET framework (Visual Basic)
 - development of Web content using ASP, JavaScript, jQuery, HTML and CSS
- Experience with C#, VB, AD/Windows Domain required
- Working knowledge of MS SQL Server Management Studio, SSRS, Crystal Reports is required
- Must have the ability to document at both a technical and non-technical level
- Excellent communication skills and interpersonal skills; ability to work in a team environment as well as independently is required
- Must be highly self-motivated & project oriented.
- Knowledge of Design Patterns and best practices of software development preferred
- Must possess a strong customer service attitude and be able to demonstrate initiative
- Positive willingness to learn to develop skills in new technologies required
- Must have own transportation and valid driver's license
