Under the supervision of the Marina Manager, the Marina Services Attendant obtains and posts current weather check/forecast. She/he raises and lowers the flag. She/he monitors and operates Very High Frequency (VHF) radio in communication with boats in distress. She/he monitors activities of marina and private boats and responds to those requiring emergency assistance, utilizing equipment provided (Rescue Boat or Dinghy). She/he ensures that emergency marina rescue boats and equipment are in good condition, outboard fuel tanks are full, rescue/tow lines are readily available, and equipment deficiencies are brought to the supervisor's attention.
