Responsibilities:

To provide leadership to the School-Age Program by ensuring the day-to-day operations of the Before & After Program by ensuring all of the requirements laid out in the Child Care & Early Years Act 2014 (CCEYA).

Qualifications:

- Early Childhood Education Diploma (registration with the College of Early Childhood Educators in good standing), Social Services, or related field diploma
- Experience leading children's activities
- Ability to work independently and within a team environment
- A minimum of one year experience preferred
- Current certification in First Aid/CPR-C Certificate
- Verification of the required immunizations/immunity, as required by the local Medical Officer of Health
- Vulnerable Sector Record Check (includes Criminal Record & Judicial Matters Check) and Children's Aid Society Declaration/Release
- Possession of a valid driver's licence, \$2 million vehicle liability insurance, clear Driver Abstract and use of a vehicle.
