- Locations: Various sites across Haldimand and Norfolk Counties
- Wage: \$17.60 per hour (some positions may pay a higher hourly wage)

The Summer Assistant positions are within our Early Learning & Care, Family Early Intervention Program, Youth & Justice Services, Developmental Services, and Autism & Behaviour Services, where they will directly support children and youth while developing transferable skills such as communication, teamwork, adaptability, problem-solving, creativity, and the use of digital systems.

Some examples of the roles the Summer Assistants may fill include:

- Supporting summer day camps, children in licenced childcare and childcare classroom inclusion
- Supporting children and youth with a Developmental Disability and/ or Autism
- Supporting our youth and justice programs

Eligibility:

Applicants must meet the below criteria for the Canada Summer Jobs 2026 Program

To be eligible, youth must:

- be aged between 15 and 30 years old (at the start of the summer job)
- be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, or someone who has been officially given refugee protection in Canada **and**
- be legally allowed to work in Canada (this includes having a valid Social Insurance Number (SIN) at the start of the summer job)

Qualifications:

- Experience working/volunteering with children/youth
- Post-secondary education in a related field (completed or in process) considered an asset
- Certification in Standard First Aid/CPR-C required
- A minimum of one year of experience preferred
- Verification of the required immunizations/immunity, as recommended by the local Medical Officer of Health
- Vulnerable Sector Record Check (includes Criminal Record & Judicial Matters Check), some positions may require a Broad Record Check
- Children's Aid Society Declaration/Release
- Possession of a valid driver's licence, \$2 million vehicle liability insurance, clear Driver Abstract and use of a vehicle (for some positions)
