#### **Responsibilities:**

- Provide in-person and/at times virtual mental health competency-based psychotherapy and coordinated care to children/youth up to 18 years who have been identified as having extensive behavioural, neurodevelopmental, mental health, medical and social vulnerabilities and their families using evidence informed approaches such as CBT, DBT, Narrative Therapy, EFFT, expressive arts, play oriented therapy and trauma-focused modalities.
- Completion of program related clinical documentation and assessments
- Service coordination and consultation with community partners

#### **Qualifications:**

- Bachelor's degree in the Social Sciences from a University of recognized standing or acceptable equivalent
- Registered or qualifying to perform the Controlled Act of Psychotherapy in the province of Ontario
