- Performs diagnostic echocardiography procedures and optimizes equipment/protocols to ensure high quality images
- Performs cardiac stress testing and ECGs
- Is aware of and follows all departmental and hospital policies and procedures
- Troubleshoots technical problems to assist service person and expedite service/repair
